Cotton Acreage Highest Since 2012 All Rice Acreage Down 8 Percent From 2016 Soybean Acreage Up 14 Percent From 2016 Wheat Acreage Lowest On Record

Corn: Louisiana corn growers intend to plant 500,000 acres, down 19 percent from last year's 620,000 acres.

Cotton: All cotton acreage intentions are at 190,000 acres, up 36 percent from last year's 140,000 acres.

Hay, All: All hay acres expected to be harvested in Louisiana are estimated at 360,000 acres, down 20,000 acres from 2016.

<u>Rice</u>: Intended planted acres for all rice for 2017 are 400,000 acres, down 8 percent from the previous year's 437,000 acres. Long grain rice acres are down 38,000 acres from last year, while medium grain acres are up 1,000 acres from a year ago.

Sorghum: Sorghum growers intend to plant 25,000 acres, down 52 percent from last year. If realized, this will be the lowest planted acres since 1965, when 17,000 acres were planted.

<u>Soybeans</u>: Soybean growers intend to plant 1.40 million acres in 2017, up 14 percent from last year.

Sugarcane: The first 2017 estimate of sugarcane acreage for harvest will be available on June 30, 2017.

<u>Sweet Potatoes</u>: Sweet potato growers intend to plant 10,000 acres, unchanged from last year.

Winter Wheat: Wheat acreage in Louisiana is down 20 percent from last year to an estimated 20,000 acres planted for all purposes in 2017. If realized, this will be the lowest planted acres on record dating back to 1955.
