#### January 1 Louisiana All Cattle Inventory Up 1 Percent from Last Year Milk Cows and Milk Replacement Heifers at Record Lows for Louisiana

<u>Cattle:</u> All cattle and calves in Louisiana as of January 1, 2017, totaled 780,000 head, were up 1 percent from January 1, 2016. The calf crop for the full year of 2016 was 350,000 head, up 1 percent from last year. All cows and heifers that have calved, at 460,000 head, were up 1 percent from January 1, 2016; beef cows, at 448,000 head, were up 1 percent; and milk cows, at 12,000 head, were down 8 percent and an all time record low. All heifers weighing 500 pounds and over were down 1 percent at 109,000 head. Steers were up 14 percent at 25,000 head; bulls were up 3 percent at 31,000 head, and calves weighing less than 500 pounds were up 1 percent at 155,000 head.

**Goats:** On January 1, 2017, Louisiana meat and other goat inventory totaled 18,000 head, down 5 percent from the revised previous year.


