Week Ending: September 8, 2019

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Louisiana, there were 6.8 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, September 8, 2019. Topsoil moisture supplies were 12 percent very short, 48 percent short, 37 percent adequate, and 3 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 7 percent very short, 20 percent short, 68 percent adequate, and 5 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 66.3 degrees Fahrenheit at Homer to 80.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Galliano. Highs ranged from 92.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Slidell and Jennings to 101.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Minden. Precipitation was scarce throughout the State, with the highest concentration in the southeast part of the State with an average of 0.48 inch.
