



Louisiana Chick Placements Up 27 Percent from Last Year

Broiler-type chicks placed for meat production in Louisiana were 3.10 million during the week ending February 24, 2018. Placements were up 27 percent from the comparable week in 2017 and up 9 percent from the previous week.

Louisiana hatcheries set 3.36 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending February 24, 2018, down 10 percent from the same period last year and down 8 percent from the previous week.

Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the United States Up 2 Percent

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 228 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 24, 2018, up 2 percent from a year ago. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 82 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the United States Up 1 Percent

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 181 million chicks for meat production during the week ending February 24, 2018, up 1 percent from a year ago. Cumulative placements from the week ending January 6, 2018 through February 24, 2018 for the United States were 1.45 billion. Cumulative placements were up 1 percent from the same period a year earlier.
