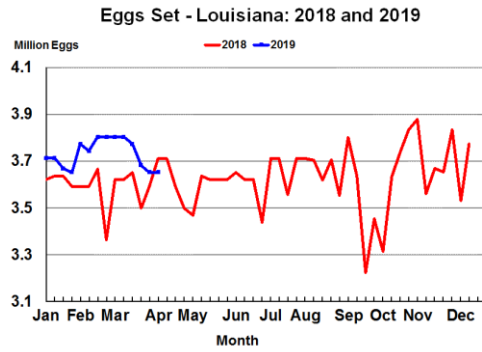
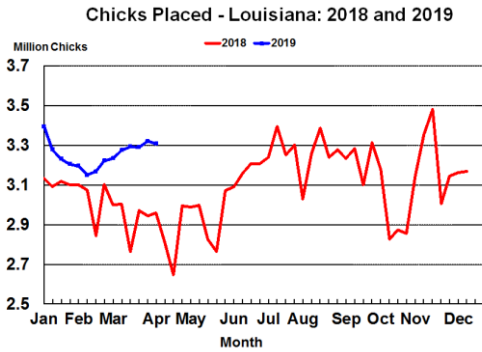

**Chick Placements Up 12 Percent from Last Year**

Broiler-type chicks placed for meat production in Louisiana were 3.31 million during the week ending April 6, 2019. Placements were up 12 percent from the comparable week in 2018 but down slightly from the previous week.

Louisiana hatcheries set 3.65 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending April 6, 2019, down 2 percent from the same period last year but unchanged from the previous week.

**Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the United States Up 1 Percent**

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 231 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 6, 2019, up 1 percent from a year ago. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 82.3 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

**Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the United States Up 2 Percent**

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 187 million chicks for meat production during the week ending April 6, 2019, up 2 percent from a year ago. Cumulative placements from the week ending January 5, 2019 through April 6, 2019 for the United States were 2.58 billion. Cumulative placements were up 1 percent from the same period a year earlier.
