



#### **Chick Placements Up 1 Percent from Last Year**

Broiler-type chicks placed for meat production in Louisiana were 2.87 million during the week ending October 20, 2018. Placements were up 1 percent from the comparable week in 2017 and up 2 percent from the previous week.

Louisiana hatcheries set 3.74 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending October 20, 2018, up 12 percent from the same period last year and up 3 percent from the previous week.

## Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the United States Down 1 Percent

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 214 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 20, 2018, down 1 percent from a year ago. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 82.7 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

### **Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the United States Up Slightly**

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 172 million chicks for meat production during the week ending October 20, 2018, up slightly from a year ago. Cumulative placements from the week ending January 6, 2018 through October 20, 2018 for the United States were 7.68 billion. Cumulative placements were up 1 percent from the same period a year earlier.
