



Louisiana Chick Placements Up 1 Percent from Last Year

Broiler-type chicks placed for meat production in Louisiana were 2.97 million during the week ending October 7, 2017. Placements were up 1 percent from the comparable week in 2016 but down 2 percent from the previous

Louisiana hatcheries set 3.65 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending October 7, 2017, up 6 percent from the same period last year and up 7 percent from the previous week.

Revisions made to the previous four-week's data during the current week are published in this report. Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the United States Up 3 Percent

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 217 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 7, 2017, up 3 percent from a year ago. Hatcheries in the 19 State weekly program set 208 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 7, 2017, up 3 percent from the year earlier. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 83 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the United States Up 3 Percent

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 175 million chicks for meat production during the week ending October 7, 2017, up 3 percent from a year ago. Broiler growers in the 19 State weekly program placed 167 million chicks for meat production during the week ending October 7, 2017, up 3 percent from the year earlier. Cumulative placements from the week ending January 7, 2017 through October 7, 2017 for the United States were 7.24 billion. Cumulative placements were up 2 percent from the same period a year earlier.
