



### Louisiana Chick Placements Up Slightly from Last Year

Broiler-type chicks placed for meat production in Louisiana were 3.00 million during the week ending October 14, 2017. Placements were up slightly from the comparable week in 2016 and up 1 percent from the previous

Louisiana hatcheries set 3.33 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending October 14, 2017, down 3 percent from the same period last year and down 4 percent from the previous week.

## **Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the United States Up 4 Percent**

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 218 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 14, 2017, up 4 percent from a year ago. Hatcheries in the 19 State weekly program set 209 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 14, 2017, up 4 percent from the year earlier. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 83 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

### **Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the United States Up 2 Percent**

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 179 million chicks for meat production during the week ending October 14, 2017, up 2 percent from a year ago. Broiler growers in the 19 State weekly program placed 172 million chicks for meat production during the week ending October 14, 2017, up 1 percent from the year earlier. Cumulative placements from the week ending January 7, 2017 through October 14, 2017 for the United States were 7.42 billion. Cumulative placements were up 2 percent from the same period a year earlier.
