Louisiana March 1, 2017, Rough Rice Stocks Up 13 Percent Compared To March 1, 2016


Louisiana rough rice stocks in all positions on March 1, 2017, totaled 8.20 million hundredweight (cwt), up 13 percent compared to March 1, 2016. Stocks held on farms totaled 2.30 million cwt, compared to 1.70 million cwt last year. Off-farm stocks totaled 5.90 million cwt, up 6 percent from last year.



March 1, 2017, Grain Stocks

Louisiana corn stocks at off-farm grain storage facilities on March 1, 2017, totaled 28.2 million bushels, down slightly from March 1, 2016. **Soybeans** at off-farm storage facilities totaled 6.20 million bushels, up 18 percent from a year earlier. **All Wheat** at off-farm storage facilities totaled 4.29 million bushels, down 10 percent from a year earlier.
